

PETITION Improve the Bloor Street, Rail Road Bridge

To The Mayor of Toronto, Chair of C.N.R. and the Minister of Transportation

WHEREAS Bloor Street West between Lansdowne Avenue and Dundas Street West has been identified as the only stretch of Bloor Street that has no landscaping.

WHEREAS the Neighborhood near 1369 Bloor Street West has been recognized as a priority revitalization area by the City of Toronto study in 2000.

WHEREAS items for beautification include:

- 1. Developing terraced walls with flowers and planters near the Rail Road Bridge;
- 2. Constructing new abutment walls;
- 3. Cleaning, planting and reconstructing the rusty dilapidated Rail Road Bridge;
- 4. Creating brightly lit murals underneath the Bridge in order to make it more secure and more people friendly.

Therefore, we, the undersigned request in the strongest terms that our City Government immediately re-activates the 2000 reconstruction plan and C.N.R. immediately proceed with improvements to the Bridge.

We look forward to a dynamic, revitalized community enhanced by a beautiful continuous cityscape. We want to be proud to live here.
